GOD IS OUR LOVING FATHER, HE IS MERCIFUL AND Just! DIOS ES NUESTRO PADRE AMOROSO, ¡ES MISERICORDIOSO Y JUSTO!

2 Chronicles 36:14-16, 19-23
Psalm 137:1-2,3,4-5,6
Ephesians 2:4-10
John 3:14-21

God could have saved us quite easily with a wink in his eyes or a click of his fingers without going through the many covenants he had established first with Noah, the covenant with Abraham, and the Sinai Covenant with Moses and the covenant with David. He had been so patient with His chosen people who do not heed the law He gave them. The reason for this is that God is rich in mercy. Although God is also just. God punished the Jews by sending them to exile in our first reading today. But the exile was not the end of it all, he ushered them back and brought them new life through his only begotten Son.

Today's liturgy conveys to us that God loved us so much that he brings us to life, after having been dead to sin, (an experience of exile) Christ ransomed us from death and brought us divine life. Of course, he did it because of his mercy and love.

The whole world is in waiting for God's saving act of love since we have been alienated, estranged and waits for the redemption brought by Christ death and resurrection.

Christians today could recite effortlessly with conviction one of the famous verses in the Bible from John 3:16 "For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might

have eternal life." I hope we understand it very well that God loved the world, not a chosen few as some of us would claim. He loves everyone, he loves us all unconditionally, those who are lonely, those who are abandoned, neglected, strangers, poor and rich alike, good and bad, even those who does not believe in him. As St. Augustine says "God loves us as if there was only one of us to love."

What about those who does not accept and love him in return because the promise is clear eternal life to those who believes in him? It is my problem and my fault if I insist on refusing to believe, to listen and to accept Christ in faith, I am the one who condemns myself. God does not want to condemn us! It is my action that will condemn my very self. In the end it is up to me if I want to be saved or not.

Dios podría habernos salvado muy fácilmente con un guiño de sus ojos o un chasquido de sus dedos sin pasar por los muchos pactos que había establecido primero con Noé, el pacto con Abraham, el Pacto del Sinaí con Moisés y el pacto con David. Había sido tan paciente con su pueblo escogido que no había prestado atención a la ley que les había dado. La razón de esto es que Dios es rico en misericordia. Aunque Dios también es justo. Dios castigó a los judíos enviándolos al exilio en nuestra primera lectura de hoy. Pero el exilio no fue el final de todo, él los hizo regresar y les trajo nueva vida a través de su Hijo unigénito.

La liturgia de hoy nos transmite que Dios nos amó tanto que nos trae a la vida, después de haber estado muertos al pecado, (una experiencia de exilio), Cristo nos rescató de la muerte y nos trajo la vida divina. Por supuesto, lo hizo por su misericordia y amor.

El mundo entero está esperando el acto salvador de amor de Dios ya que hemos sido alienados, distanciados y espera la redención traída por la muerte y resurrección de Cristo.

Los cristianos de hoy podrían recitar sin esfuerzo y con convicción uno de los famosos versículos de la Biblia de Juan 3:16: "Porque tanto amó Dios al mundo que dio a su único Hijo, para que todo el que cree en él no perezca, sino que tenga vida eterna." Espero que entendamos muy bien que Dios amó al mundo, no a unos pocos elegidos como algunos de nosotros diríamos. Él ama a todos, nos ama a todos incondicionalmente, a los que están solos, a los abandonados, a los extranjeros, a los pobres y a los ricos, a los buenos y a los malos, incluso a los que no creen en él. Como dice San Agustín "Dios nos ama como si solo hubiera uno de nosotros a quien amar".

¿Qué pasa con aquellos que no lo aceptan ni lo aman a cambio porque la promesa es clara de vida eterna para quienes creen en él? Es mi problema y mi culpa si insisto en negarme a creer, a escuchar y a aceptar a Cristo en la fe, soy yo quien me condeno. ¿Dios no quiere condenarnos! Es mi acción la que me condenará a mí mismo. Al final depende de mí si quiero ser salvo o no.

INVITATION TO MASS of the CHRISM

The Most Reverend Robert F. Vasa, Bishop of the Diocese of Santa Rosa, along with the Diocesan and Religious priests of the Diocese invite you to participate in the Mass of the Chrism at the Cathedral of St. Eugene in Santa Rosa on Thursday, March 21, 2024 at 5:30 p.m. The Mass of the Chrism is celebrated once a year. The Bishop blesses the oil of Catechumens, the oil of the Sick and the oil of Chrism. This Mass is one of the principal expressions of the fullness of the ministerial priesthood that the bishop has received. It also signifies the unity the priests have with the bishop who share in the same ministerial priesthood. During this Mass, the Diocesan and Religious priests will renew their commitment of priestly service.
