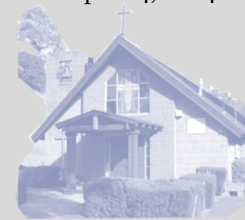

Years ago, I, a lifelong Protestant, found myself drawn to the Catholic Church. This revelation, both wonderful and terrifying, changed the course of my life. I needed help on this journey and found it through the television program, 'The Journey Home.' As I listened to the conversion stories of pastors and lay people, my desire for the church that Jesus founded flamed into passion. One of the most enlightening aspects of the program, a segment entitled, 'The Verse I Never Saw,' brings me to my first reflection of today's Gospel. I had read the story of "The Road to Emmaus," but didn't grasp what the two disciples meant when they said, "He was made known to them in the breaking of the bread." In my background, the bread and grape juice served at communion were symbols. And they remained as such until Jesus did for me, what He did for the group gathered in Jerusalem... 'He opened my mind to understand the scriptures.' I'll never forget reading this passage again, after searching for the truth of Catholicism and praying for guidance. My eyes fell on those same words, but this time I paused and said, "This is the Eucharist!" But God didn't stop there. More scriptures jumped out as if highlighted. I discovered Jesus gave His mother Mary to us while on the cross, and conferred the sacrament of confession to the priests, the successors of the apostles. I also found that our Lord gifted priests with the mystery of transubstantiation to change bread and wine into His body and blood. These examples are a glimpse of the awe-inspiring moments that drove me towards Mother Church. My second reflection centers on how often Jesus says, "Be not afraid, or why are you troubled?" Which is what He said to the group of frightened men when He appeared out of nowhere, while the two travelers shared their story. Like me, you might think, isn't fear a natural response to massive waves tossing your boat, or Jesus suddenly appearing in your midst? The difference is... Jesus doesn't operate in the natural. He operates in the supernatural. He says, "I am with you always." Think about that. He is with us in all circumstances all the

time. The question is, are we with Him all the time? In today's Gospel, He showed them his hands and feet and said, "Touch me." You and I need to stay that close to Jesus if we want to live without fear.

Hace años, yo, un protestante de toda la vida, me sentí atraído por la Iglesia Católica. Esta revelación, maravillosa y aterradora, cambió el curso de mi vida. Necesitaba ayuda en este viaje y la encontré a través del programa de televisión "El viaje a casa". Mientras escuchaba las historias de conversión de pastores y laicos, mi deseo por la iglesia que Jesús fundó se convirtió en pasión. Uno de los aspectos más esclarecedores del programa, un segmento titulado "El versículo que nunca vi", me lleva a mi primera reflexión sobre el Evangelio de hoy. Había leído la historia de "El camino a Emaús", pero no entendí lo que querían decir los dos discípulos cuando dijeron: "Se les dio a conocer al partir el pan". En mi pasado, el pan y el jugo de uva que se servían en la comunión eran símbolos. Y así permanecieron hasta que Jesús hizo por mí, lo que hizo por el grupo reunido en Jerusalén... 'Abrió mi mente para entender las Escrituras'. Nunca olvidaré volver a leer este pasaje, después de buscar la verdad del catolicismo y orando por guía. Mis ojos se posaron en esas mismas palabras, pero

esta vez hice una pausa y dije: "¡Esta es la Eucaristía!" Pero Dios no se detuvo ahí. Más escrituras saltaron como si estuvieran resaltadas. Descubrí que Jesús nos dio a su madre María mientras estaba en la cruz y confirió el sacramento de la confesión a los sacerdotes, los sucesores de los apóstoles. También descubrí que nuestro Señor dotó a los sacerdotes con el misterio de la transubstantiación para transformar el pan y el vino en Su cuerpo y sangre. Estos ejemplos son un vistazo de los momentos impresionantes que me llevaron hacia la Madre Iglesia. Mi segunda reflexión se centra en la frecuencia con la que Jesús dice: "No temáis, ¿o por qué os turbáis?" Que es lo que le dijo al grupo de hombres asustados cuando apareció de la nada, mientras los dos viajeros compartían su historia. Como yo, podrías pensar, ¿no es el miedo una respuesta natural a las olas masivas que sacuden tu barco, o a la aparición repentina de Jesús entre tí? La diferencia es... Jesús no opera en lo natural. Opera en lo sobrenatural. Él dice: "Yo estoy con vosotros siempre". Piénsalo. Él está con nosotros en todas las circunstancias todo el tiempo. La pregunta es: ¿estamos con Él todo el tiempo? En el Evangelio de hoy, les mostró las manos y los pies y les dijo: "Tóquenme". Tú y yo debemos permanecer tan cerca de Jesús si queremos vivir sin miedo.
