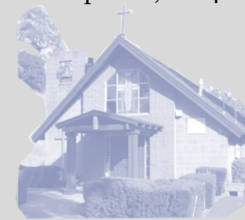

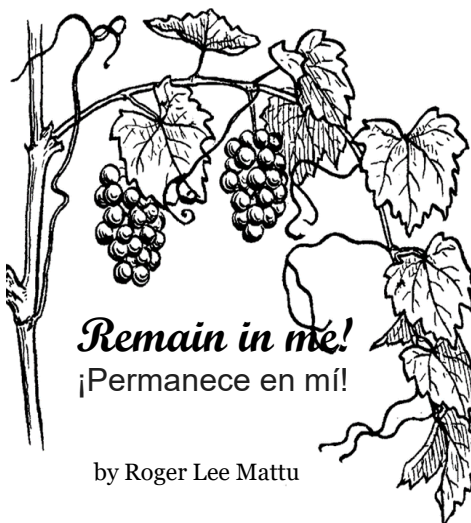

To those who keep his commandments remain in him and he in them..."

In today's Gospel readings, our Lord Jesus instructs us on the importance of faith and belief to our success as missionary disciples through the example of the vine. He teaches us, "Remain in me, as I remain

Todos hemos sufrido. Pero la solución no es permitírnos convertirnos en víctimas y caer en una vida de agravios, sino recordar lo que todos sabemos. Al igual que Bernabé y los productores de Alexander Valley, nuestra fe y creencia en nuestro Señor es lo que nos permite superar la adversidad y lograr todas las cosas. En la Segunda Lectura de hoy, San Juan nos ofrece estas palabras: "...debemos creer en el nombre de su Hijo Jesucristo y amarnos unos a otros como él nos mandó. En las lecturas del Evangelio de hoy, nuestro Señor Jesús nos instruye sobre la importancia de la fe y la creencia para nuestro éxito como discípulos misioneros a través del ejemplo de la vid. Él nos enseña: "Permaneced en mí, como yo permanezco en vosotros. Así como un rama no puede dar fruto por sí solo si no permanece en la vid, así tampoco vosotros si no permanecéis en mí". y, "Si permanecéis en mí y mis palabras permanecen en vosotros, pedid lo que queráis y os dará hecho. En esto es glorificado mi Padre: en que deis mucho fruto y seáis mis discípulos".
