Pentecost Sunday is celebrated 50 days after Jesus' Resurrection, it marks the exaltation of Jesus and the sending of the promise paraclete, the Holy Spirit. The apostles were all filled with the Holy Spirit according to the first reading today. In the one Spirit we are all baptized into a single body. Everyone of us have been given to drink of the one Spirit according to the second reading. This speaks of our confirmation which is administered once. "All of us have been given to drink" is in Greek an Aorist (*Epotisthemen*) and thus expresses one action, not a repeated action. That is the indication that we are only confirmed once. In the gospel today Christ commissioned the apostles and us: "Receive the Holy Spirit!"

Someone had asked me when do we received the Holy Spirit? Is not that we received the Holy Spirit during baptism? In one Spirit we are all baptized but we received the fullness of the Holy Spirit in Confirmation. Let us be reminded of the formula of Confirmation when the bishop anoints our forehead with chrism saying your name and "be sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit."

What is the role of the Holy Spirit in our Christian life? As Christians we are reminded that the Holy Spirit as he is the bond of unity between the Father and Son. Unity is his gift, we are also called to oneness, wholeness and peace. As I always said in my homily during baptism that the Holy Spirit, we received during baptism become for us the means of entry into the Kingdom of heaven. The Holy Spirit effects the unity in the Body of Christ by baptism. And it is being consolidated and strengthened by the sacrament of confirmation.

Therefore, the Holy Spirit makes us members of the Body of Christ in baptism and seals us (Eph 1:13), he makes us full-fledged members in confirmation. But after we were baptized and confirmed, human as we are we still succumb to our frailties and fall back to sin. Sin destroys, that oneness we have with God, that unity with the Holy Spirit that binds

us to God. But the same Holy Spirit makes us whole again in the sacrament of Confession. The risen Lord gives his apostles and his priests the power to forgive sins. In John 20:22-23 "Jesus breathed on them and said: 'Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive men's sins, they are forgiven them; if you hold them bound, they are held bound.'"

We may always have the recourse to the Holy Spirit at all time in our life.

El Domingo de Pentecostés se celebra 50 días después de la Resurrección de Jesús, marca la exaltación de Jesús y el envío del paráclito prometido, el Espíritu Santo. Según la primera lectura de hoy, todos los apóstoles fueron llenos del Espíritu Santo. En el único Espíritu somos todos bautizados en un solo cuerpo. A cada uno de nosotros se nos ha dado de beber del único Espíritu según la segunda lectura. Esto habla de nuestra confirmación que se administra una vez. "A todos nosotros se nos ha dado de beber" es en griego un aoristo (*Epotisthemen*) y por lo tanto expresa una acción, no una acción repetida. Ésa es la indicación de que sólo estamos

confirmados una vez. En el evangelio de hoy, Cristo comisionó a los apóstoles y a nosotros: "¡Recibid el Espíritu Santo!" Alguien me había preguntado ¿cuándo recibimos el Espíritu Santo? ¿No es que recibimos el Espíritu Santo durante el bautismo? En un solo Espíritu todos somos bautizados pero recibimos la plenitud del Espíritu Santo en la Confirmación. Recordemos la fórmula de la Confirmación cuando el obispo unge nuestra frente con el crisma diciendo su nombre y "sellarse con el don del Espíritu Santo".

¿Cuál es el papel del Espíritu Santo en nuestra vida cristiana? Como cristianos se nos recuerda que el Espíritu Santo es el vínculo de unidad entre el Padre y el Hijo. La unidad es su don, nosotros también estamos llamados a la unidad, la plenitud y la paz. Como siempre dije en mi homilía durante el bautismo, el Espíritu Santo que recibimos durante el bautismo se convierte para nosotros en el medio de entrada al Reino de los cielos. El Santo efectúa la unidad en el Cuerpo de Cristo por el bautismo. Y está siendo consolidado y fortalecido por el sacramento de la confirmación.

Por tanto, el Espíritu Santo nos hace miembros del Cuerpo de Cristo en el bautismo y nos sella (Ef 1,13), nos hace miembros plenos en la confirmación. Pero después de ser bautizados y confirmados, humanos como somos, todavía sucumbimos a nuestras debilidades y volvemos al pecado. El pecado destruye esa unidad que tenemos con Dios, esa unidad con el Espíritu Santo que nos une a Dios. Pero el mismo Espíritu Santo nos vuelve a íntegramente en el sacramento de la Confesión. El Señor resucitado da a sus apóstoles y a sus sacerdotes el poder de perdonar los pecados. En Juan 20:22-23 "Jesús sopló sobre ellos y dijo: Recibid el Espíritu Santo. Si perdonáis los pecados de los hombres, a ellos les quedan perdonados; si los mantienes atados, quedarán atados".

Siempre podremos recurrir al Espíritu Santo en todo momento de nuestra vida.
