The Holy Triune God has revealed himself throughout the history of humanity, in nature and continues revealing himself in our hearts. “If anyone loves me, he will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him.” (John 14:23). We were taught that God is in heaven above (a transcendent God) and yet at the same time he is present on earth with us (an Immanent God). This is the theme of the first reading. While the second reading describe to us a God who is a Father. And in the gospel we are made disciples of Christ. Thus Christ sends out his apostles to make disciples of all nations, the horizon of doing mission here is no longer confine to the borders of Israel but all nations. We are called not just mere listeners but doers of the word of God and thus make us followers and becoming one with Him.

This Sunday we are not just celebrating an ordinary feast. The feast of the Blessed Trinity is a great mystery we celebrate, it is dedicated to a doctrine: That there is only one God, that he has only one divine nature; but there are three persons in this Triune God. Some of us would say that this is not for us ordinary Christians, this doctrine is for Theologians and scholars. Who can unravel this great a mystery? We rationalized and say we know for certain that a mystery remains a mystery. So what is there for us to understand. We understand by loving the mystery. We are being enveloped into this mystery through faith. Understand-

ing by loving and believing. The most beautiful of all these is that Christ empowers and encourages us to call God “Abba”, “Papa”, Daddy as he did. But it is the Holy Spirit in us that cries out “Abba”, Father! Because the Holy Spirit is the bond of fellowship in the Blessed Trinity. This fellowship between God and us found its expression in prayer. Since it is the Holy Spirit who prays in us and for us the prayer of the children who cries “Abba-Father”.

May we become the reflection of the communion of love of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. And radiate their kindness to all people we meet each day!

El Santo Dios Trino se ha revelado a lo largo de la historia de la humanidad, en la naturaleza y continúa revelándose en nuestros corazones. “El que me ama, mi palabra guardará, y mi Padre lo amará, y vendremos a él y haremos con él nuestro hogar”. (Juan 14:23). Se nos enseñó que Dios está arriba en el cielo (un Dios trascendente) y, sin embargo, al mismo tiempo está presente en la tierra con nosotros (un Dios inmanente). Éste es el tema de la primera lectura. Mientras que la segunda lectura nos describe a un Dios que es Padre. Y en el evangelio somos hechos discípulos de Cristo. Así Cristo envía a sus apóstoles a hacer discípulos a todas las naciones, el horizonte de hacer misión aquí ya no se limita a las fronteras de Israel sino a

todas las naciones. Somos llamados no sólo meros oyentes sino hacedores de la palabra de Dios y así hacernos seguidores y convertimos en uno con Él.

Este domingo no celebramos simplemente una fiesta cualquiera. La fiesta de la Santísima Trinidad es un gran misterio que celebramos, está dedicada a una doctrina: Que hay un solo Dios, que tiene una sola naturaleza divina; pero hay tres personas en este Dios Triuno. Algunos de nosotros diríamos que esto no es para nosotros, los cristianos comunes y corrientes, esta doctrina es para teólogos y eruditos. ¿Quién podrá desentrañar este gran misterio? Racionalizamos y decimos que sabemos con certeza que un misterio sigue siendo un misterio. Entonces, ¿qué hay que entender? Entendemos amando el misterio. Estamos siendo envueltos en este misterio a través de la fe. Comprender amando y creyendo. Lo más hermoso de todo esto es que Cristo nos empodera y anima a llamar a Dios “Abba”, “Papá”, Papi como él lo hacía. Pero es el Espíritu Santo en nosotros el que clama “¡Abba”, Padre! Porque el Espíritu Santo es vínculo de comunión en la Santísima Trinidad. Esta comunión entre Dios y nosotros encontró su expresión en la oración. Ya que es el Espíritu Santo quien ora en nosotros y por nosotros la oración de los niños que clama “Abba-Padre”.

Que seamos reflejo de la comunión de amor del Padre, del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo. ¡E irradiar su amabilidad a todas las personas que conocemos cada día!
