



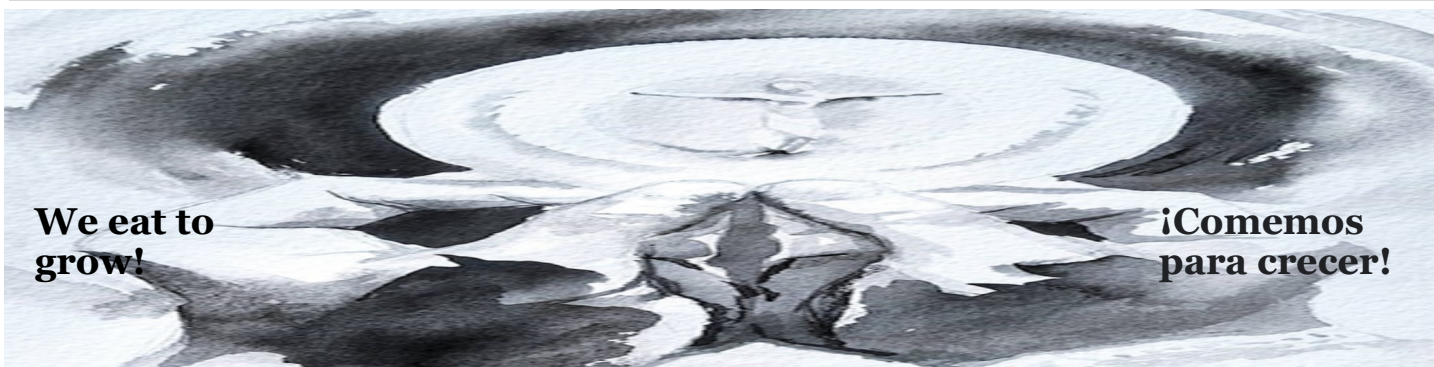

**We eat to grow!**

**¡Comemos para crecer!**

The sealing of the Old Covenant is through the blood of animals (first reading) and the New Covenant was sealed by the Blood of Christ (second reading). Therefore, the Holy Eucharist is the sacrifice that sealed the New Covenant where we partake and eat Christ's body and drink his blood for our salvation. However, the gospel today is divided into two parts: the preparations of the Passover (Mk. 14:12-16) and the Institution of the Eucharist (Mk 14:22-26).

The event at Mt. Sinai after God had completed the covenant with Moses, when God ordered Moses to come up the Mountain with seventy elders. They did so. Exodus 24: 11 adds: "They saw God: They were eating and drinking." They went to see God by eating and drinking meaning partaking the covenant meal. This covenant meal is a banquet.

When we go to the Eucharistic banquet in reality is to behold Christ's face and go on living. It could also mean to be with Christ, in his presence as Moses and the seventy elders were with God on Mt. Sinai.

We eat not only three times a day. We eat as we like the whole day. Eating does not just give us physical nourishment but it gives us joy when we satiate our hunger. But there is a higher form of hunger that we experience that could not be satiated by any physical food. The hunger for spiritual nourishment which could only be satisfied by the

Eucharist.

The meaning of the Eucharistic banquet is we eat to grow. Our divine life which we receive in Baptism has to grow by eating the Eucharistic food. If you are only baptized and could not receive and eat the Eucharist it means you are not growing in divine life and you are currently suffering from spiritual starvation.

As Catholics what is the implication of the Eucharist in our lives? Its implication is that by participating in the Eucharistic sacrifice we must also be willing to offer ourselves as a living sacrifice. As St. Paul urges us in Roman 12:1 "Offer your bodies as a living sacrifice holy, and acceptable to God, your spiritual worship." Let us not forget my dear brothers and sisters that our daily life and duties are a continuation of the Eucharistic Sacrifice we participated every mass.

El pacto de la Antigua Alianza es mediante la sangre de animales (primera lectura) y la Nueva Alianza fue sellada con la Sangre de Cristo (segunda lectura). Por lo tanto, la Sagrada Eucaristía es el sacrificio que selló el Nuevo Pacto donde participamos y comemos el cuerpo de Cristo y bebemos su sangre para nuestra salvación. Sin embargo, el evangelio de hoy se divide en dos partes: los preparativos de la Pascua (Mc 14,12-16) y la institución de la Eucaristía (Mc 14,22-26).

El evento en el Monte Sinaí después de que Dios completó el pacto con Moisés, cuando Dios le ordenó a Moisés que subiera a la montaña con setenta ancianos. Así lo hicieron. Éxodo 24:11 añade: "Vieron a Dios: comían y bebían". Fueron a ver a Dios comiendo y bebiendo, lo que significa participar de la comida del pacto. Esta comida del pacto es un banquete.

Cuando vamos al banquete eucarístico en realidad es para contemplar el rostro de Cristo y seguir viviendo. También podría significar estar con Cristo, en su presencia como Moisés y los setenta ancianos estaban con Dios en el monte Sinai.

No solo comemos tres veces al día. Comemos como nos gusta durante todo el día. Comer no sólo nos da alimento físico sino que también nos da alegría cuando saciamos nuestro hambre. Pero existe una forma superior de hambre que experimentamos y que no puede ser saciada con ningún alimento físico. El hambre de alimento espiritual que sólo puede satisfacerse con la Eucaristía.

El significado del banquete eucarístico es que comemos para crecer. Nuestra vida divina que recibimos en el Bautismo tiene que crecer comiendo el alimento eucarístico. Si sólo estás bautizado y no pudiste recibir ni comer la Eucaristía, significa que no estás creciendo en la vida divina y actualmente estás sufriendo de hambre espiritual.
