The liturgy this 12th Sunday in Ordinary time teaches us that God, thus Christ, is the Lord of the world, that the sea and the wind obey him we learn this lesson from our gospel reading today. And in the first reading; in the beginning of creation God puts the sea its limit. And the second reading we are reminded that the Father created everything through His Son and our being a new creation through baptism.

We believe that all creation obeys God and he has put limits on them so that they cannot harm us. But if we look at the many calamities that happened in the world, like the tsunami in Indonesia in 2004, the Super Typhoon Haiyan (locally known in the Philippines as Yolanda) in 2013, the Northridge earthquake in 1994, the most recent Covid '19 and so many innumerable disasters that havoc the earth for centuries. All those tragedies claimed lots of lives. And some people asked does God not in control of nature and why does he have to allow them to bring death to many people. How then can we understand God's plans why he lets people suffer? Is he a cruel God? Does he really care about us? Is he far remote from us, or is he an absentminded God? The answer to all these questions is the example of Job, he apologizes for having to question God's marvelous design for the Universe and in the end submit to the Divine providence of God.

In the gospel Christ did not just show us that he is the master of all the elements in the universe and all creation. Looking at the incident on the crossing of the sea in the boat, Christ was fast asleep. Could make us question, does he really care that we are perishing? This is a beautiful image of the Church, Christ is with us always, it may seem sometimes that he is with us and yet does not intervene in our affairs and being indifferent to our sufferings. And sometimes we think that he comes to our aid when the storm is over. But Christ assures us "Do not be afraid. I have overcome the world" (Jn 16:33). We will surely overcome any

hardships because he is with us, even if sometimes we do not feel his very presence.

In the life example of St. Therese of Avila, we learn that when she was greatly suffering from temptations that she felt that all her prayers seemed in vain, so powerless and that the Lord is so far away from her. And when all her temptation were gone the following day, she complained to the Lord and said: "Lord where were you in all my temptations?" And the Lord responded to her: "In your heart."

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La liturgia de este duodécimo domingo del tiempo ordinario nos enseña que Dios, por tanto Cristo, es el Señor del mundo, que el mar y el viento le obedecen. Esta lección la aprendemos de la lectura del evangelio de hoy. Y en la primera lectura; en el principio de la creación Dios pone al mar su límite. Y la segunda lectura se nos recuerda que el Padre creó todo a través de Su Hijo y nuestro ser una nueva creación a través del bautismo.

Creemos que toda la creación obedece a Dios y él les ha puesto límites para que no puedan hacernos daño. Pero si miramos las muchas calamidades que sucedieron en el mundo, como el tsunami en Indonesia en 2004, el súper tifón Haiyan (conocido localmente en Filipinas como Yolanda) en 2013, el terremoto de Northridge en 1994, el más reciente Covid '19 y tantos innumerables desastres que asolan la tierra durante siglos. Todas esas tragedias cobraron muchas vidas. Y algunas personas preguntaron si Dios no tiene el control de la naturaleza y por qué tiene que permitirles traer la muerte a muchas personas. ¿Cómo entonces podemos entender los planes de Dios por los cuales deja sufrir a la gente? ¿Es un Dios cruel? ¿Realmente se preocupa por nosotros? ¿Está muy lejos de nosotros o es un Dios distraído? La respuesta a todas estas preguntas es el ejemplo de Job, él se disculpa por tener que cues

tionar el maravilloso diseño de Dios para el Universo y al final someterse a la Divina providencia de Dios.

En el evangelio, Cristo no solo nos mostró que él es el amo de todos los elementos del universo y de toda la creación. Al contemplar el incidente del cruce del mar en la barca, Cristo estaba profundamente dormido. Podría hacernos preguntarnos: ¿realmente le importa que estemos pereciendo? Esta es una bella imagen de la Iglesia, Cristo está con nosotros siempre, puede parecer a veces que está con nosotros y sin embargo no interviene en nuestros asuntos y siendo indiferente a nuestros sufrimientos. Y a veces pensamos que él viene en nuestra ayuda cuando pasa la tormenta. Pero Cristo nos asegura "No temáis. Yo he vencido al mundo" (Jn 16,33). Seguramente superaremos cualquier dificultad porque él está con nosotros, aunque a veces no sintamos su presencia.

En el ejemplo de vida de Santa Teresa de Ávila, aprendemos que cuando sufría mucho por las tentaciones, sentía que todas sus oraciones parecían en vano, tan impotentes y que el Señor estaba tan lejos de ella. Y cuando todas sus tentaciones pasaron al día siguiente, se quejó al Señor y dijo: "Señor, ¿dónde estuviste en todas mis tentaciones?" Y el Señor le respondió: "En tu corazón".

"Nada te turbe, nada te espante Dios no se muda, la paciencia todo lo alcanza, quien a Dios tiene nada le falta!" – Santa Teresa de Avila
