The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want

Jer 23:1-6 Ps 23:1-3, 3-4, 5, 6 Eph 2:13-18 Mk 6:30-34

Today's readings vividly depict God's care and guidance, inviting us to rest in His presence and trust His compassionate leadership.

Jeremías 23:1-6 Sal 23:1-3, 3-4, 5, 6 Efesios 2:13-18 Marcos 6:30-34

Las lecturas de hoy descri-

ben vívidamente el cuidado y la guía de Dios, invitándonos a descansar en Su presencia y confiar en Su liderazgo compasivo.

Psalm 23 beautifully portrays God as our loving Shepherd who provides, guides, and protects us. The opening verse, "The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want," sets the tone for the psalm, affirming God's provision and care. The imagery of green pastures and still waters evokes peace and restfulness, showing that God leads us to places of nourishment and tranquility. Even in the darkest valleys, the psalmist fears no evil because of God's comforting presence. This psalm encourages us to trust deeply in God's guidance and care, confident that He provides for our needs and restores our souls.

In Mark 6:30-34, Jesus embodies the Good Shepherd. When the apostles return from their mission, He recognizes their need for rest and invites them to a deserted place. His compassion shows His understanding of human needs and concern for His followers' wellbeing. However, as they retreat, the crowd follows, seeking Jesus. Moved with compassion, He sees them as "sheep without a shepherd" and begins to teach them. This passage highlights Jesus' deep empathy and commitment to guide and nurture those who seek Him, even at the expense of His own rest.

Both passages reflect God's heart as our Shepherd, who deeply cares for and understands our needs. Psalm 23 shows a God who leads us to peace and restoration in every circumstance. Mark 6 shows Jesus, the Good Shepherd, responding compassionately to the needs of the crowd with love and patience.

These readings invite us to recognize the presence of our Shepherd in our daily lives, trust Him to lead us to rest and renewal, and follow His example of compassion by extending His love and guidance to others. As we reflect on these passages, let us trust in His unfailing love and follow Him with faith and confidence.

El Salmo 23 retrata maravillosamente a Dios como nuestro Pastor amoroso que nos provee, guía y protege. El versículo inicial, "El Señor es mi pastor; nada me faltará", establece el tono del salmo, afirmando la provisión y el cuidado de Dios. Las imágenes de pastos verdes y aguas tranquilas evocan paz y descanso, mostrando que Dios nos lleva a lugares de alimento y tranquilidad. Incluso en los valles más oscuros, el salmista no teme ningún mal debido a la reconfortante presencia de Dios. Este salmo nos anima a confiar profundamente en la guía y el cuidado de Dios, confiados en que Él satisface nuestras necesidades y restaura nuestras almas.

En Marcos 6:30-34, Jesús encarna al Buen Pastor. Cuando los apóstoles regresan de su misión, Él reconoce su necesidad de descanso y los invita a un lugar desierto. Su compasión muestra su comprensión de las necesidades humanas y su preocupación por el bienestar de sus seguidores. Sin embargo, mientras se retiran, la multitud los sigue buscando a Jesús. Movido a compasión, los ve como "ovejas sin pastor" y comienza a enseñarles. Este pasaje resalta la profunda empatía y el compromiso de Jesús de guiar y nutrir a quienes lo buscan, incluso a expensas de su propio descanso.

Ambos pasajes reflejan el corazón de Dios como nuestro Pastor, que se preocupa y comprende profundamente nuestras necesidades. El Salmo 23 muestra a un Dios que nos lleva a la paz y la restauración en toda circunstancia. Marcos 6 muestra a Jesús, el Buen Pastor, respondiendo compasivamente a las necesidades de la multitud con amor y paciencia.

Estas lecturas nos invitan a reconocer la presencia de nuestro Pastor en nuestra vida diaria, a confiar en Él para que nos lleve al descanso y la renovación, y a seguir Su ejemplo de compasión extendiendo Su amor y guía a los demás. Al reflexionar sobre estos pasajes, confiemos en Su amor inagotable y sigámoslo con fe y confianza.




