Psalms 34: 2-9; Ephesians 4:30-542; 1 Kings 19:4-8 John 6: 41 - 51; Psalms 16

Salmos 34: 2-9; Efesios 4:30-542; 1 Reyes 19:4-8 Juan 6: 41 - 51; Salmos 16

In the bible, we heard and read lots of stories like the prodigal son, a man asked for all his inheritance from his father and left and spent all his wealth; the story of Isaac and Job, Caleb and Joshua. All these stories showed us how a person turned away to God and yet realized the goodness of Him and turned back to Him.

Many of us try to Find the so-called " Happiness and Joy". Have we ever thought about " finding wise Joy and Real Happiness?" In the First reading, Elijah wanted to give up and asked the Lord to end his life. But then the lord sent an Angel and brought him Food to make him stronger to continue his journey for forty days.

In the second reading, God reminded us of the work of the Holy Spirit in our lives. How it strengthens us and is compassionate, forgiving and loving.

Today's Gospel is teaching us to "Follow Jesus." For he said, "I am the Bread of life, whoever eats this Bread will live forever, this is my Flesh for the life of the world," David in Psalm 16 declared the wisdom of finding joy in God; "Lord you alone are my portion and my cup". He wrote, "therefore, my heart is glad and my tongue rejoices and my body will rest secure. And like the Prodigal son, when he returned to His Father, the Father threw a feast and clothed him. For the Father no other than God. God knows that the lamb that ran away was found.

How does finding wise joy bless our lives? How can it inspire us to name the ways we find joy in God? Where have we seen transformation and healing happen? What could celebration in that moment look like? When will we say "yes" to God? Will we just be like those people in the Gospel just murmuring about him?

In our life's journey, allow God to bless us to find the wise joy that starts in us. We have much to celebrate and this joy flows from us and our work in life. Let the Holy Spirit enlighten our path. Man does not live by bread alone but by the words that come from the mouth of God.

En la Biblia, escuchamos y leímos muchas historias como la del hijo pródigo, un hombre que le pidió a su padre toda su herencia y se fue y gastó toda su riqueza; la historia de Isaac y Job, Caleb y Josué. Todas estas historias nos mostraron cómo una persona se apartó de Dios y, sin embargo, se dio cuenta de su bondad y regresó a Él.

Muchos de nosotros tratamos de encontrar la llamada "Felicidad y Alegría". ¿Alguna vez hemos pensado en "encontrar la Alegría sabia y la Felicidad Real"? En la Primera lectura, Elías quería darse por vencido y le pidió al Señor que terminara con su vida. Pero entonces el Señor envió un Ángel y le trajo comida para fortalecerlo para continuar su viaje durante cuarenta días. En la segunda lectura, Dios nos recordó la obra del Espíritu Santo en nuestras vidas. Cómo nos fortalece y es compasivo, perdonador y amoroso.

El Evangelio de hoy nos enseña a "Seguir a Jesús". Porque él dijo: "Yo soy el Pan de vida, el que come de este Pan vivirá para siempre, esta es mi Carne para la vida del mundo", David en el Salmo 16 declaró la sabiduría de encontrar alegría en Dios; "Señor, tú solo eres mi porción y mi copa". Escribió: "Por eso, mi corazón se alegra y mi lengua se regocija y mi cuerpo descansará seguro. Y como el hijo pródigo, cuando regresó a su Padre, el Padre hizo un banquete y lo vistió. Para el Padre nadie más que Dios. Dios sabe que el cordero que huyó fue encontrado.

¿Cómo bendice nuestras vidas el encontrar la alegría sabia? ¿Cómo puede inspirarnos a nombrar las formas en que encontramos alegría en Dios? ¿Dónde hemos visto que se produce la transformación y la sanación? ¿Cómo podría ser una celebración en ese momento? ¿Cuándo le diremos "sí" a Dios? ¿Seremos como aquellos que en el Evangelio sólo murmuraban sobre Él? 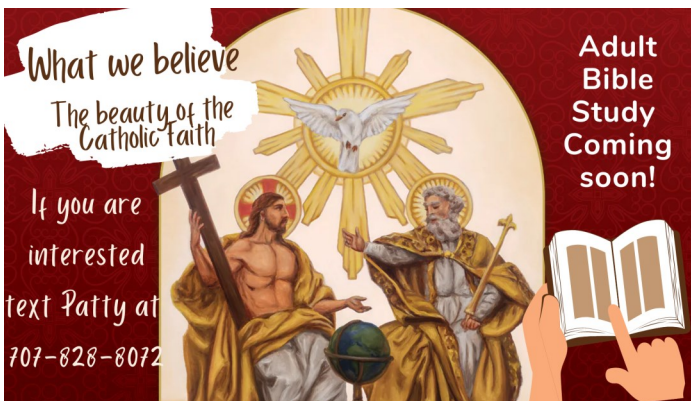
