**Ears were made
for listening!**

As the world's fastest blind runner, David Brown of the U.S. paralympic team credits his win to God, his mother's early advice "no sitting around" and his running guide - Veteran sprinter Jerome Avery. Avery guides Brown's winning race with words and touches.

"It's all about listening to his cues", says Brown, who says he could "swing out wide" on 200- meter races where the track curves. "Day in and day out, we're going over race strategies." Brown says, "communicating with each other- not only verbal cues, but physical cues."

In today's Gospel, the people brought to Jesus a deaf man with speech difficulties. They begged Him to lay His hands on him to be cured. Jesus pulled the man aside away from the crowd and told him "Ephphatha" means "be opened". The man 's ears opened and his speech was straightened. Jesus brought the man back to the crowd and ordered them not to tell anyone. But they don't listen. Instead, they Were exceedingly astonished, proclaiming it.

People refused to use their ears to hear the Lord's Voice. God is constantly at work in our lives communicating words of love, instructions, encouragement and caution. He sends the Holy Spirit as a helper to lead our steps when we follow Him. Like the people in the Gospel, we often "gossip" of what we hear. Instead of praying with thanks and asking God's manifestation of what He wanted us to experience, we first make it a sensational talk.

Our ears can help us mature our Faith, if we listen. The Holy spirit will warm, guide and direct us so we can run to truth and not to lie. We as followers and believers of Christ, are we the blind runner or the people in the gospel? Do we use our ears to listen to God's heart?

*"Heavenly Father, we believe you are always speaking,

David Brown, el corredor ciego más rápido del mundo, del equipo paralímpico de Estados Unidos, atribuye su victoria a Dios, al consejo temprano de su madre (no quedarse sentado" y a su guía en la carrera, el veterano velocista Jerome Avery. Avery guía la carrera ganadora de Brown con palabras y caricias.

"Todo se trata de escuchar sus señales", dice Brown, quien dice que podía "salir con mucha amplitud" en carreras de 200 metros donde la pista tiene curvas. "Día tras día, repasamos las estrategias de carrera", dice Brown, "comunicarnos entre nosotros, no sólo con señales verbales, sino también físicas".

En el Evangelio de hoy, la gente trajo a Jesús a un hombre sordo con dificultades del habla. Le rogaron que pusiera las manos sobre él para curarlo. Jesús apartó al hombre de la multitud y le dijo "Ephphatha" que significa "ábrete". Los oídos del hombre se abrieron y su habla se enderezó. Jesús trajo al hombre de vuelta a la multitud y les ordenó que no se lo dijeran a nadie. Pero ellos no escuchan, sino que, llenos de asombro, proclaman la Palabra de Dios.

La gente se niega a utilizar sus oídos para oír la voz del Señor. Dios está trabajando constantemente en nuestras vidas comunicando palabras de amor, instrucciones, aliento y advertencia. Él envía al Espíritu Santo como ayudador para guiar nuestros pasos cuando lo seguimos. Al igual que las personas del Evangelio, a menudo "chismorreamos" sobre lo que oímos. En lugar de orar con agradecimiento y pedirle a Dios que manifieste lo que Él quiere que experimentemos, primero lo convertimos en una conversación sensacionalista.

Nuestros oídos pueden ayudarnos a madurar nuestra fe, si escuchamos. El Espíritu Santo nos calentará, nos guiará y nos dirigirá para que podamos correr hacia la verdad y no hacia la mentira. Nosotros, como seguidores y creyentes de Cristo, ¿somos los corredores ciegos o las personas del Evangelio? ¿Usamos nuestros oídos para escuchar el corazón de Dios?

perdona mi obstinada tendencia a pensar que tengo todas
las respuestas. Abre mis oídos para que pueda escuchar".
