## Deliver Me Jesus from the desire of being esteemed.



Reflecting on this week's readings, several powerful themes emerge, each inviting us to embrace humility and a broader sense of purpose beyond ourselves.

Who doesn't love being recognized when they are working hard. Recognition and appreciation of others is important to every human being. "Appreciation weeks" wouldn't be a thing if it was not important to us. As a teacher it is beyond amazing to hear a heartfelt thank you for all the work I do with kiddos. It can be hard when you have a lapse in time where you feel like you are not appreciated.

In today's readings I think we are challenged to look past wanting praise and appreciation for what we do for others. The wisdom described here offers a vision of peace cultivated through humility and service. It urges us to seek what benefits the collective rather than just our individual desires. This aligns with the Gospel reading, where Jesus teaches that true greatness lies in servitude. By prioritizing the well-being of others, we embody the essence of humility that He exemplifies.

My favorite way to seek improvement in my humility is by praying the litany of humility. It is a wonderful prayer asking Jesus to deliver us from desires and fears all in relation to becoming a more humble follower of Our Lord Jesus Christ. I challenge us to pray the Litany of Humility this week and ask Jesus the meek and humble of heart, to deliver us from the desire of being esteemed and much more.

La sabiduría descrita aquí ofrece una visión de paz cultivada a través de la humildad y el servicio. Nos insta a buscar lo que beneficia al colectivo en lugar de solo nuestros deseos individuales. Esto se alinea con la lectura del Evangelio, donde Jesús enseña que la verdadera grandeza radica en la servidumbre. Al priorizar el bienestar de los demás, encarnamos la esencia de la humildad que Él ejemplifica.

Mi forma favorita de buscar mejorar mi humildad es rezando la letanía de la humildad. 

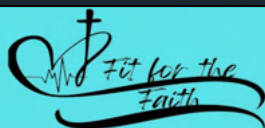
