Sunday Readings Reflection

In the Gospel passage for the Twenty Sunday in Ordinary Time Jesus shares lessons on acceptance and modesty. According to Johns account someone was casting out demons in Jesus' name. Jesus advises not to hinder them saying "whoever is not against us is for us." This serves as a reminder that Gods influence is not confined to a group or individual. Much like Eldan and Medan in the reading from Numbers, who prophesied despite not being, among the chosen elders God can work through anyone. We are encouraged to celebrate when others perform acts of kindness in the name of Christ by embracing humility and coming together in unity, for Gods purpose.

Reflexión sobre las lecturas del domingo

Según el relato de Juan, alguien estaba expulsando demonios en nombre de Jesús. Jesús aconseja no obstaculizarlos diciendo "quien no está contra nosotros, está con nosotros". Esto sirve como recordatorio de que la influencia de Dios no se limita a un grupo o individuo. Al igual que Eldan y Medan en la lectura de Números, quienes profetizaron a pesar de no estar entre los ancianos elegidos, Dios puede obrar a través de cualquiera. Se nos anima a celebrar cuando otros realizan actos de bondad en nombre de Cristo, abrazando la humildad y uniéndonos en unidad, para el propósito de Dios.

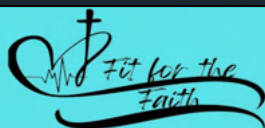
