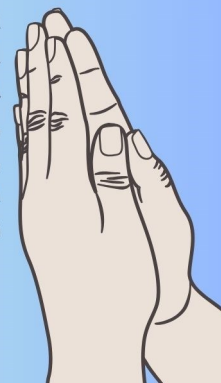

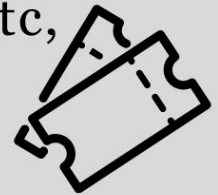

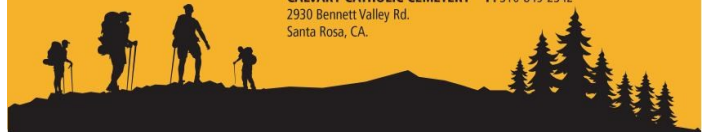

Sunday Readings Reflection

The Gospel prompts us to contemplate the essence of leadership from the perspective of Christ's teachings. James and John eager for positions of power, ask to sit at Jesus' right and left in His glory. However Jesus transforms their request into a lesson on genuine greatness—a concept rooted in service and selflessness rather than power or prestige. This narrative questions society's view of leadership as synonymous, with authority and acclaim. Jesus demonstrates that leadership within the realm of God is centered around humility and a commitment to serving others.

We can take this teaching and incorporate it into our everyday experiences, whether in our homes or workplaces or within our communities! We frequently perceive leaders as supervisors at work or prominent figures in society or even our own parents. To society a leader is an individual with authority and control over others' lives. However, Jesus challenges this perspective by suggesting that the effective leaders are those who prioritize service and empowerment of others rather than asserting control. In our lives too we can mirror this approach by placing importance on the needs of others over our own desires by providing assistance without expecting acknowledgment and, by willingly assuming roles that may appear insignificant or underappreciated.

Consider a scenario where a parent selflessly looks after their kids without seeking acknowledgment for doing laundry and cooking meals while comforting a sobbing child in need of solace. Just like how Jesus demonstrated love through service to His disciples and ultimate sacrifice for all of us. An effective leader doesn't rely on their power to intimidate or brag; instead they back their team, foster growth and set a positive example even if it entails tackling challenging tasks personally.

Jesus' teachings serve as a reminder that true greatness is not defined by titles or lofty positions; rather it is reflected in our actions towards others. Showing love and compassion with humility, at the core of our values. A genuine leader is not measured by authority or control they exert. By their willingness to serve others selflessly, mirroring Jesus who dedicated His life to serving and sacrificing for the well-being of others.

Reflexión sobre las lecturas del domingo

El Evangelio nos lleva a contemplar la esencia del liderazgo desde la perspectiva de las enseñanzas de Cristo. Santiago y Juan, ansiosos de ocupar puestos de poder, piden sentarse a la derecha y a la izquierda de Jesús en su gloria. Sin embargo, Jesús transforma su petición en una lección de verdadera grandeza, un concepto arraigado en el servicio y el altruismo más que en el poder o el prestigio. Esta narración cuestiona la visión que tiene la sociedad del liderazgo como sinónimo de autoridad y aclamación. Jesús demuestra que el liderazgo en el ámbito de Dios se centra en la humildad y el compromiso de servir a los demás.

Podemos tomar esta enseñanza e incorporarla a nuestras experiencias cotidianas, ya sea en nuestros hogares, lugares de trabajo o dentro de nuestras comunidades. Con frecuencia percibimos a los líderes como supervisores en el trabajo o figuras prominentes en la sociedad o incluso como nuestros propios padres. Para la sociedad, un líder es un individuo con autoridad y control sobre las vidas de los demás. Sin embargo, Jesús desafía esta perspectiva al sugerir que los líderes eficaces son aquellos que priorizan el servicio y el empoderamiento de los demás en lugar de afirmar el control. En nuestra vida también podemos reflejar este enfoque al dar importancia a las necesidades de los demás por encima de nuestros propios deseos, brindando ayuda sin esperar reconocimiento y asumiendo voluntariamente roles que pueden parecer insignificantes o poco apreciados.

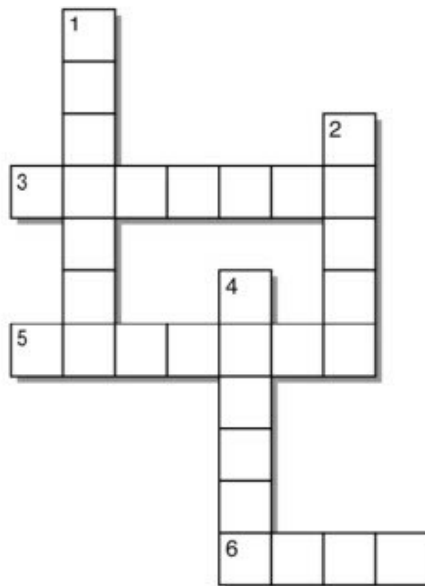
Consideremos un escenario en el que un padre cuida desinteresadamente a sus hijos sin buscar reconocimiento por lavar la ropa y cocinar mientras consuela a un niño que llora y necesita consuelo. Tal como Jesús demostró amor a través del servicio a sus discípulos y el sacrificio máximo por todos nosotros. Un líder eficaz no depende de su poder para intimidar o alardear; en cambio, respalda a su equipo, fomenta el crecimiento y da un ejemplo positivo incluso si implica abordar tareas desafiantes personalmente.

Las enseñanzas de Jesús sirven como recordatorio de que la verdadera grandeza no se define por títulos o posiciones elevadas; más bien, se refleja en nuestras acciones hacia los demás. Mostrar amor y compasión con humildad es el núcleo de nuestros valores. Un líder genuino no se mide por la autoridad o el control que ejerce. Por su disposición a servir a los demás desinteresadamente, reflejando a Jesús, quien dedicó su vida a servir y sacrificarse por el bienestar de los demás.
