How do I place Christ in the center of my life? ¿Cómo coloco a Cristo en el centro de mi vida?



The answer is with today's liturgical readings which is centered on the theme of: "Be converted and believe!"

Here our first reading sets in: The Lord summons Jonah to preach repentance to Nineveh. Jonah did as God has commanded him and the effect is that the Ninevites do penance, put on sackcloth and ashes and thus saved.

In our second reading St. Paul talks about marriage and virginity. He exhorts the people that marriage is good and allowed, but it is indissoluble. But as far as it concerned the apostles, he wishes that all would remain celibate as he does. Our invitation is that we should strive to live in such a way that we are not attached to anything, neither to the married state nor to living the single life, neither to fullness or want, neither to sorrow or joy. We are living in the end times. He reminded us that the Lord may come anytime. That is the reason why we must be ready anytime.

And the gospel reading has two themes for us to reflect upon: Conversion and a call to discipleship. When the disciples heard the call and they followed him, they placed him in the center of their life. They are able to do this because they experience him as the one who calls with authority when Jesus said to them: "Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men." Their response is abandoned what they are doing and followed the Lord. They understood that nothing is above over obedience to God. They fall in love to the one whom they cannot resist. Only somebody who has fallen in love with Christ can also make

others fall in love with the Lord, and thus could become a fisher of men.

What is Jesus calling you to abandon in order to follow him? For few of us, it may like quitting a job and entering formation to the priesthood or religious life. For some, it may be dropping that obsession or hobby that controls our thoughts, emotions and any inordinate affections for vices that keep us from prayer and serving the people around us lovingly. For others, it may mean putting a full stop at a wrong relationship or unhealthy relationship that does not allow us to place Christ in the center of our life.

La respuesta está en las lecturas litúrgicas de hoy, que se centran en el tema: "¡Convertíos y creed!"

Aquí comienza nuestra primera lectura: El Señor convoca a Jonás a predicar el arrepentimiento en Nínive. Jonás hizo lo que Dios le había ordenado y el efecto es que los ninivitas hacen penitencia, se visten de cilicio y ceniza y así se salvan. En nuestra segunda lectura San Pablo habla del matrimonio y la virginidad. Exhorta al pueblo a que el ma-

trimonio es bueno y está permitido, pero es indisoluble. Pero en lo que respecta a los apóstoles, desea que todos permanezcan célibes como él. Nuestra invitación es que nos esforcemos por vivir de tal manera que no estemos apegados a nada, ni al estado matrimonial ni a vivir la vida de soltería, ni a la plenitud ni a las necesidades, ni a la tristeza o la alegría. Estamos viviendo en los últimos tiempos. Nos recordó que el Señor puede venir en cualquier momento. Ésa es la razón por la que debemos estar preparados en cualquier momento.

Y la lectura del evangelio tiene dos temas sobre los que reflexionar: la conversión y un llamado al discipulado. Cuando los discípulos escucharon el llamado y lo siguieron, lo pusieron en el centro de su vida. Pueden hacerlo porque lo experiencia como quien llama con autoridad cuando Jesús les dijo: "Venid en pos de mí, y os haré pescadores de hombres". Su respuesta es abandonar lo que están haciendo y seguir al Señor. Entendieron que nada está por encima de la obediencia a Dios. Se enamoran de aquel a quien no pueden resistir. Sólo alguien que se ha enamorado de Cristo puede hacer que otros también se enamoren del señor, y así convertirse en pescador de hombres.

¿Qué te llama Jesús a abandonar para seguirlo? Para pocos de nosotros, puede ser como dejar un trabajo y entrar en formación para el sacerdocio o la vida religiosa. Para algunos, puede ser abandonar esa obsesión o pasatiempo que controla nuestros pensamientos, emociones y cualquier afecto desmedido por vicios que nos impiden orar y servir con amor a las personas que nos rodean. Para otros, puede significar poner un final a una relación equivocada o poco saludable que no nos permite colocar a Cristo en el centro de nuestra vida.

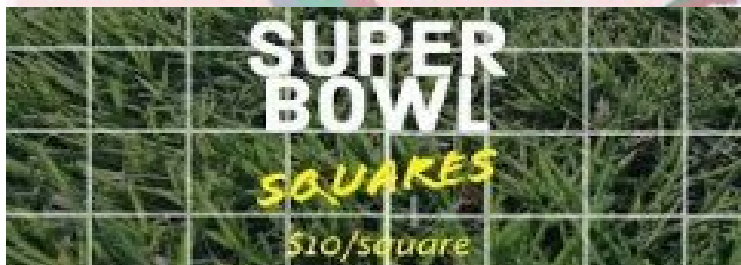

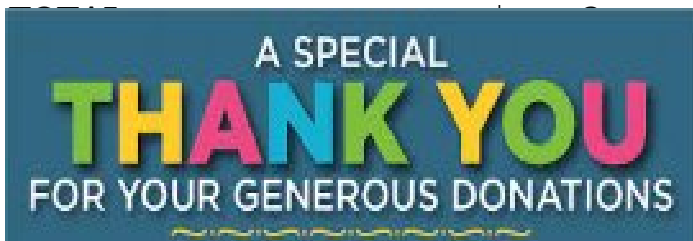

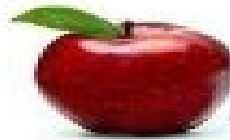
