¿AM I A CAFETERIA CATHOLIC? ¿SOY CATÓLICO DE CAFETERÍA?

Whenever we behold our Lord crucified on the cross, being raised up for us reminds us of the ultimate freedom won by Christ for our salvation. There is freedom in fulfilling the Father's will. Likewise, for us there is absolutely that great freedom in being able to say I come to do your will oh God. Our grumbling about how we practice our religion and how we behave inside our Churches is a form of unfreedom or the lack of it.

Finally, if we put together the thoughts of the readings of our liturgy this Sunday, we can summarize the Law (first reading) the Crucified Christ, stumbling block, foolishness, the power and the wisdom of God (second reading) and the Cleansing of the temple (gospel) into the temple of Christ's body. The temple is the embodiment of the law and a symbol of Christ redeeming death on the cross and his resurrection when He said: "Destroy this temple and in three days I will raise it up."

Following the law, and believing in the founder of the religion of the cross should not make us a cafeteria Christian rather should make us a flame in freedom of faith and action.

¡Conocí a alguien que me dijo que no viene a la Iglesia porque "la Iglesia se trata de dinero"! Una pareja que vive junta durante muchos años no quiere casarse porque dicen "en el momento en que se casen, sucederán problemas y el matrimonio terminará en divorcio". Algunas personas dicen que son creyentes pero luego no necesitan asistir a la misa dominical porque ¡pueden orar en casa! Algunos me dijeron que dejaron

de asistir la Iglesia por completo, ¡es porque "la Iglesia Católica tiene tantas reglas que seguir"!

Si entendemos la verdadera razón por la cual Dios nos ha dado los mandamientos, no tendremos que recurrir a todas las racionalizaciones comunes por las cuales debemos practicar la religión. Que en realidad la ley vivida en el amor libera y conduce a la libertad. Bellamente expresado en nuestro Salmo responsorial: "La ley del Señor es perfecta para refrescar el alma; el decreto del Señor es confiable, que da sabiduría a los simples". Precisamente tenemos que confiar y vivir los mandamientos de Dios porque son fuente de sabiduría, iluminan nuestros ojos, nos hacen justos, nos hacen puros y finalmente nos señalan la vida eterna.

Cada vez que contemplamos a nuestro Señor crucificado en la cruz, ser resucitado por nosotros nos recuerda la libertad suprema ganada por Cristo para nuestra salvación. Hay libertad en el cumplimiento de la voluntad del Padre. Asimismo, para nosotros existe absolutamente esa gran libertad de poder decir vengo a hacer tu voluntad oh Dios. Nuestras quejas sobre cómo practicamos nuestra religión y cómo nos comportamos dentro de nuestras Iglesias es una forma de falta de libertad o de falta de ella.

Finalmente, si juntamos el pensamiento de las lecturas de nuestra liturgia de este domingo, podemos resumir la Ley (primera lectura), el Cristo Crucificado, piedra de tropiezo, la necedad, el poder y la sabiduría de Dios (segunda lectura) y la Purificación del templo (evangelio) en el templo del cuerpo de Cristo. El templo es la encarnación de la ley y un símbolo de Cristo redentor, la muerte en la cruz y su resurrección cuando dijo: "Destruid este templo y en tres días lo levantaré".

Seguir la ley y creer en el fundador de la religión de la cruz no debería convertirnos en cristianos de cafetería, sino más bien debería convertirnos en una llama de libertad de fe y acción.

I met someone who told me that he does not come to Church because "the Church is all about money"! A couple who lives together for many years does not want to get married because they said "the moment they get married problems would happen and the marriage ends up in divorce"! Some people say they are believers but then do not need to attend Sunday Mass because they can just pray at home! Some told me that they stopped altogether coming to Church is it because "the Catholic Church has so many rules to follow"!

If we understand the truest reason for which God has given us the commandments, we will not have to resort to all the common rationalizations for which we must practice religion. That in reality the law live out in love liberates and leads us to freedom. Beautifully expressed in our responsorial Psalm: "the law of the Lord is perfect refreshing the soul; the decree of the Lord is trustworthy, giving wisdom to the simple." Precisely we have to trust and live out God's commandment because they are source of wisdom, they enlighten our eyes, they make us just, and they make us pure and finally they point us to everlasting life.

This Mass is one of the principal expressions of the fullness of the ministerial priesthood that the bishop has received. It also signifies the unity the priests have with the bishop who share in the same ministerial priesthood.
