A Manifestation to the World Sunday, January 5, 2024

When Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea, in the days of King Herod, behold, magi from the east arrived in Jerusalem, saying, "Where is the newborn king of the Jews? We saw his star at its rising and have come to do him homage." Matthew 2:1-2

The Magi were most likely from Persia, modern-day Iran. They were men who regularly engaged in a study of the stars. They were not Jewish but were most likely aware of the popular belief of the Jewish people that a king would be born who would save them.

These Magi were called by God to encounter the Savior of the World. Interestingly, God used something very familiar to them as an instrument of their calling: the stars. It was among their belief that when someone of great importance was born, this birth was accompanied by a new star. So when they saw this new, bright and brilliant star, they were filled with curiosity and hope. One of the most significant aspects of this story is that they responded. God called them through the use of a star, and they chose to follow this sign, embarking on a long and arduous journey.

God often uses those things most familiar to us that are part of our daily life to send forth His calling. Recall, for example, that many of the Apostles were fishermen, and Jesus used their occupation to call them, making them "fishers of men." He especially used the miraculous catch of fish to clearly indicate to them that they had a new calling. In our own lives, God is constantly calling us to seek Him out and worship Him. He will often use some of the most ordinary parts of our lives to send forth that calling. How is He calling you? In what way is He sending you a star to follow? Many times when God speaks, we ignore His voice. We must learn from these Magi and diligently respond when He calls. We must not hesitate and must seek to daily be attentive to the ways that God invites us to deeper trust, surrender and worship.

Reflect, today, upon God's call in your life. Are you listening? Are you responding? Are you ready and willing to abandon all else in life so as to serve His holy will? Seek Him, wait on Him and respond. Doing so will be the best decision you ever make.

Lord, I love You and pray that I will be open to Your guiding hand in my life. May I always be attentive to the countless ways that You call to me each and every day. And may I always respond to You with all my heart. Jesus, I trust in You.

Una manifestación al mundo Domingo 5 de enero de 2024

Cuando Jesús nació en Belén de Judea, en los días del rey Herodes, he aquí unos magos del oriente llegaron a Jerusalén, diciendo: "¿Dónde está el rey de los judíos que ha nacido? Hemos visto su estrella en el oriente y venimos a adorarlo." Mateo 2:1-2

Los magos eran muy probablemente de Persia, el actual Irán. Eran hombres que regularmente se dedicaban al estudio de las estrellas. No eran judíos, pero probablemente eran conscientes de la creencia popular del pueblo judío de que nacería un rey que los salvaría.

Estos magos fueron llamados por Dios para encontrarse con el Salvador del mundo. Curiosamente, Dios utilizó algo muy familiar para ellos como instrumento de su llamado: las estrellas. Estaba entre sus creencias que cuando alguien de gran importancia nacía, este nacimiento era acompañado por una nueva estrella. Así que cuando vieron esta nueva, brillante y resplandeciente estrella, se llenaron de curiosidad y esperanza. Uno de los aspectos más significativos de esta historia es que respondieron. Dios los llamó mediante una estrella, y ellos eligieron seguirla, emprendiendo un largo y arduo viaje.

Dios a menudo utiliza aquellas cosas que nos resultan más familiares y que forman parte de nuestra vida diaria para enviar su llamado. Recordemos, por ejemplo, que muchos de los apóstoles eran pescadores, y Jesús utilizó su ocupación para llamarlos, convirtiéndolos en "pescadores de hombres". Utilizó especialmente la pesca milagrosa para indicarles claramente que tenían un nuevo llamado. En nuestras propias vidas, Dios nos llama constantemente a buscarlo y adorarlo. A menudo, utilizará algunas de las partes más comunes de nuestra vida para enviar ese llamado. ¿Cómo te está llamando? ¿De qué manera te está enviando una estrella para seguir? Muchas veces, cuando Dios habla, ignoramos su voz. Debemos aprender de estos magos y responder diligentemente cuando Él nos llama. No debemos dudar y debemos tratar de estar atentos diariamente a las formas en que Dios nos invita a una confianza, una entrega y una adoración más profundas.

Reflexiona hoy sobre el llamado de Dios en tu vida. ¿Estás escuchando? ¿Estás respondiendo? ¿Estás listo y dispuesto a abandonar todo lo demás en la vida para servir a Su santa voluntad? Búscalo, espéralo y responde. Hacerlo será la mejor decisión que tomes en tu vida.

Señor, te amo y te pido que esté abierto a tu mano que guía mi vida. Que siempre esté atento a las innumerables formas en que me llamas todos los días y que siempre te responda con todo mi corazón. Jesús, confío en ti.

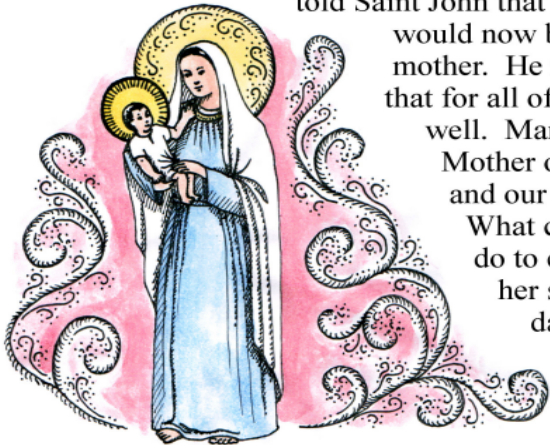
Mary the Mother of God

SAINT ANDRÉ WAS A SIMPLE MAN WHO COULD HARDLY EVEN WRITE HIS OWN NAME. BUT HIS DEVOTION TO SAINT JOSEPH AND LOVE FOR THE PEOPLE MADE EVERYONE LOVE AND TRUST HIM. WE CAN LEARN FROM HIS EXAMPLE THAT WE CAN HAVE GREAT CONFIDENCE IN THE SAINTS, ESPECIALLY ST. JOSEPH!
