Dying to live for others!

Morir por vivir para los demás!



Jeremiah 31:31-34
Psalm 51:3-4, 12-13, 14-15
Hebrews 5:7-9
John 12:2—33

The fifth Sunday of Lent allows us to revisit the Old Testament and the great covenant moments. That God will not make the same covenant they have always broken through ages passed. In the gospel Christ likened himself as he predicted his passion, death and resurrection to a grain of wheat when he said: “unless the grain of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains just a grain of wheat; but if it dies, it produces much fruit”. The first reading speaks about this harvest as the new covenant God wanted to establish and that it will be written no longer in a tablet of Stones but will place his law within them and write it upon their hearts. The second reading tells us that Christ's death through His obedience has brought us eternal salvation. That in contrast to the disobedience of the first man, Adam, brought death upon us all but the obedience of the second Adam, “Christ”, brought life and salvation to all.

As we draw ourselves to the final weeks of our Lenten observances let us enter more profoundly into the invitation of Christ to be selfless, embracing the reality of the many “little deaths” in our life as a form of our union with Christ on the Cross. That we learn to die to ourselves, to our prejudices, biases, our appetites, desire for pleasures and comforts and allow such dying to self to be accompanied by our humble obedience to the new covenant with God, rooted in prayer, acts of charity, mercy and forgiveness.

El quinto domingo de Cuaresma nos permite visitar el Antiguo Testamento y los momentos del gran pacto. Que Dios no hará el mismo pacto que siempre han roto a lo largo de los siglos. En el evangelio, Cristo se comparó a sí mismo cuando predijo su pasión, muerte y resurrección, con un grano de trigo cuando dijo: “si el grano de trigo no cae en la tierra y muere, queda sólo un grano de trigo; pero si muere, produce mucho fruto”. La primera lectura habla de esta cosecha es el nuevo pacto que Dios

quiso establecer y que ya no estará escrito en una tabla de piedras sino que pondrá su ley dentro de ellos y la escribirá en sus corazones. Y la segunda lectura nos habla de que la muerte de Cristo, por su obediencia, nos ha traído la salvación eterna. Eso, en contraste con la desobediencia del primer hombre, Adán, trajo la muerte sobre todos nosotros, pero la obediencia del segundo Adán, “Cristo”, trajo vida y salvación para todos.

Mientras nos acercamos a las últimas semanas de nuestras celebraciones de Cuaresma, entramos más profundamente en la invitación de Cristo a ser desinteresados, abrazando la realidad de muchas “pequeñas muertes” en nuestra vida como una forma de nuestra unión con Cristo en la Cruz. Que aprendamos a morir a nosotros mismos, a nuestros prejuicios, preferencias, apetitos, deseos de placeres y comodidades y permitamos que esa muerte a nosotros mismos vaya acompañada de nuestra humilde obediencia a la nueva alianza con Dios, enraizada en la oración, los actos de Caridad, misericordia y perdón.

INVITATION TO MASS OF THE CHRISM

The Most Reverend Robert F. Vasa, Bishop of the Diocese of Santa Rosa, along with the Diocesan and Religious priests of the Diocese invite you to participate in the Mass of the Chrism at the Cathedral of St. Eugene in Santa Rosa on Thursday, March 21, 2024 at 5:30 p.m. The Mass of the Chrism is celebrated once a year. The Bishop blesses the oil of Catechumens, the oil of the Sick and the oil of Chrism. This Mass is one of the principal expressions of the fullness of the ministerial priesthood that the bishop has received. It also signifies the unity the priests have with the bishop who share in the same ministerial priesthood. During this Mass, the Diocesan and Religious priests will renew their commitment of priestly service.
